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## Lyme in NC?

- Most reported cases are EM only
  - \_ One published outbreak. no evidence B. burgdorferi
- •No evidence in Chatham County study
- •No isolation of B. *burgdorferi* from any NC patient sample (skin bx) sent to CDC
- Sentinels
- Children: **no** reports **of** JRA-like clusters. NC Dogs: 4/987 (0.4%) from 2001-3 compare to VA (8.7%). MD (14.4%). PA (25%); p<0.008<sup>2</sup>
